



Older Person's Dining Centre Volunteer, West Drayton

Bell Farm Christian Centre (BFCC) is a Christian Charity that has a declared policy of working with other agencies to help meet the needs of the local community. Our services and community projects attract and support over 2500 beneficiaries each year from across the London Borough of Hillingdon but particularly in West Drayton, Yiewsley, Uxbridge and Hayes.

BFCC Older Persons Section organises a weekly lunch and social club which provides a freshly cooked meal and social contact for older people (over 60's) within the community. This is one of our most cherished initiatives with a long-standing tradition over the last twenty years of providing not just nourishment but also a vital social outlet for those at risk of isolation and loneliness.

Role Purpose:

To support at the weekly lunch club. We require a volunteer to help prep and/or serve food and chat with service users. The offer is a well-balanced nutritious meal consisting of fresh vegetables and fresh meat that is delivered each week from the butchers. We also cater for vegetarians and special dietary needs and provide tea, coffee and fresh fruit platters.
