Community Connex work with people with learning difficulties, autism, additional needs and their families. We also organise events to help people who are lonely or isolated. Main purpose of the role:

To spend a couple of hours at a supermarket collecting voluntary donations from customers on a regular basis, at times and dates that suit you.

Hours are flexible. You cover as many hours as you wish any day of the week at a location that suits you. Training will be given on using a card reader which in some stores is used in addition to a collection box.

- As you meet other volunteers and make friends you may wish to come to some of the charities events.

Role responsibilities:

- To sit in supermarkets with a collection box and to engage with customers in a non pushy way i.e. by saying good morning /afternoon so they are aware of your presence
