As an In-Patient student volunteer, you will be contributing to the day-to-day running of the Hospice.

#### **Time Commitment**

Minimum of three hours per shift a week – after school or at weekends, either 11-2 or 4-7

#### **Tasks and Activities**

- Welcoming visitors, finding chairs for them, directing them around the unit
- Distributing menus and assisting patients to make their meal choices
- Serving meals, snack and drinks to patients
- Filling up water jugs, offering drinks to visitors.
- Collecting crockery and cutlery after meals, rinsing them and keeping the kitchenette and café areas tidy
- Keep our patients' company; chatting to them, reading to them or assisting them in recreational activities if appropriate.
- Using your particular skills eg bring a musical instrument to entertain patients if there is time.

The above list is not exhaustive, and may be asked to take on other tasks to support and assist the smooth running of the Hospice.





## **Skills and Personal Qualities**

- Trustworthy and reliable.
- Excellent Communication Skills.
- Strong interpersonal skills, to deal with a diverse range of people.
- Good organisational skills.
- A flexible and non-judgmental approach to people and work.
- Enjoy working as part of a team.

#### **Dress Code**

Appropriate dress for the role to reflect the professional image of the Hospice. A volunteer badge must be worn.

### **Training and Support**

- Induction shadow a volunteer or a health care assistant for one shift
- Debrief at end of shift if required.
- Regular Hospice newsletter.
- Online Mandatory Training of agreed modules which must be completed prior to starting.
- Standard DBS Certificate which the hospice will pay for.
