Volunteer DLF Driver - Role Specification.

This is an exciting new opportunity for a friendly, active volunteer to join the Daniella Logun Foundation (DLF) based in West London as a driver.

We provide holistic wellbeing support to Children and Young People (CYP) diagnosed with brain tumours (or other cancers) and their families. When a child is diagnosed with a brain tumour, medical care takes over and the wellbeing of the child and family is inadvertently neglected. If unaddressed, this wellbeing neglect can lead to long lasting wellbeing trauma.

Feeling isolated can become a real-life challenge for many of our children who have been diagnosed with a brain tumour or other cancer and their families. This can affect the family's ability to access good quality health and social care support for their children and themselves or maintain good relationships at the point of need.

About the Role:

This role will involve experienced driving skills, friendly client interaction with DLF supervision and exposure to our ongoing community projects in:

- Holistic wellbeing support, family health & social care provision; faith support
- Community based Childhood Brain Tumour awareness programmes (Virtual)
- Advocacy and support in navigating local Health & Social Care provisions

Key Responsibilities will include:

The role of a driver is important and will give our children and their families the freedom they need to get out and about in the community as needed. Your role will involve commuting to and from pre-agreed locations within the community to support our families to:

- go to a doctor's or hospital appointment
- pick up and delivering Dannie's Gift Boxes, Food boxes etc to our families doorstep
- Get out of the house, seeing family/friends, a drive in the country, shopping trip, social activity or event
- Post-Covid19 assist with organising and attending our promotional and community stakeholder meetings and events
- Supporting with other logistics around our services as required
