About the Role:

The ideal candidate will take on a primary support role for our charity, which will include

- Book-keeping (including supporting the delivery of quarterly finance updates and yearend financial statements)
- Making invoice payments (to vendors e.g. for fundraising events and for ongoing operations)
- Providing financial guidance to the Board (e.g. providing advice or opinions on income and expenditure and suitable investment approaches upon receipt of bequest)

- Experience with bookkeeping and/or financial management (either through voluntary experience or experience in the workplace).
- Understanding of accounts and accounting processes, requirements and timescales
- Evidence of training in Accounting or a chartered accountant qualification (Desirable)
