Main Responsibilities

This particular candidate would need to be empathetic, willing to listen to others and engaging. They would help make resources and run craft activities. They would be happy to engage in a variety of activities including information sessions, sign language sessions and emotion/feelings workshops. Some knowledge of disabilities would be desired. They should have a knowledge of computers, using zoom to join virtual coffee mornings for the time being.

Training

Full training will be provided. You will be shadowing a DASH employee until you have completed your relevant training.

Reference checks will be required and a DBS will need to be obtained, the cost of this will be covered by DASH.
