

RSPCA Cattery Assistant Volunteer, Pinner

By volunteering at our cattery, you would be helping us get through the essential tasks so we can spend extra time with our cats. As well as assisting with their feeding and the cleaning of the cattery, you will also be working closely with the team allowing you to get more involved and learn new skills. This opportunity to help our cats is extremely rewarding, knowing that you have improved their welfare and made them happy whilst they are waiting for their forever home.

The RSPCA Middlesex, North West and South Hertfordshire Branch

The RSPCA Middlesex, North West and South Hertfordshire branch is one of the branches of RSPCA, but we are also a separately registered charity looking after animals in our local area. Much of the animal welfare work of RSPCA is carried out through local branches.

We currently run two catteries: one in Hemel Hempstead and one in Pinner.

Volunteer Cattery Assistant responsibilities

- Preparing and providing food and water for the cats in the cattery
- Cleaning, disinfecting and maintaining the cattery to a high standard of cleanliness, so our cats are as comfortable as possible
- Following the health and safety procedures in place at the centre and ensuring that they are always observed

What we are looking for in a volunteer Cattery Assistant

- Is comfortable around cats and has a patient and understanding nature
- Can carry out physical tasks
- Someone who is flexible and can offer an ongoing commitment predominately on Thursday, Friday and Sunday mornings between 9.30am to 11pm
- Able to work within a team but also capable of working with minimal supervision
- Volunteers need to be aged 18 or over

- A place where you will learn excellent new skills to add to your CV
- An excellent induction and training programme relevant to your role
- A fun environment at the heart of the local community

Requirements for the role / additional information

1. We're looking for people aged 18 years or over
2. We require a regular commitment of at least one 2 hour shift per week for a minimum of 6 months
3. You will receive an induction and specific training for the role
4. You will have the support of the Animal Welfare team at the RSPCA North West London and South Hertfordshire Branch
5. Volunteering to be carried out predominately on Thursday, Friday and Sunday mornings from 9.30am to 11pm
6. A reference can be requested after 4 months continuous volunteering
7. A DBS check is not required
8. Travel expenses can be claimed for this role
9. RSPCA voluntary roles are subject to an informal interview with the RSPCA and a trial period. You may need to sign an agreement
