You will be contributing to the day to day running of the Inpatient Unit by providing support to the Housekeeper; serving meals and drinks to our patients and visitors at Michael Sobell Hospice.

### **Time Commitment**

Three to four hours per shift a week.

#### **Tasks and Activities**

- Welcoming visitors, finding chairs for them and directing them around the unit.
- Distributing menus and assisting patients to make their meal choices.
- Serving of meals, snacks and drinks to patients.
- Replenish the water jugs
- Offering drinks to visitors.
- Collecting of crockery and cutlery after meals, rinsing them and keeping the kitchenette and café areas tidy.
- Keeping our patients' company; chatting to them, reading to them or assisting them in recreational activities if appropriate.
- Utilising your particular skills, for example bring a musical instrument to entertain the patients if there is time.

- Trustworthy and reliable.

- Strong interpersonal skills, to deal with a diverse range of people.
- Good organisational skills.
- A flexible and non-judgmental approach to people and work.
- Enjoy working as part of a team.
